Report for September '09.

Important aspects

- As per instructions given by Mr. Joseph State Coordinator AIMS INDIA, two tables are furnished for each month in the pages below.. one for class room and another one for Evening class activities. In the same pattern, Consolidated monthly reports are prepared for June, July and August also. You can see the reports one by one after September report with comments. Actual Monthly Reports sent by teachers are attached as PDF file and original hard copies are sent to Mr. Joseph by courier.
- Quarterly exam Mark sheets will be available only in 1st week of October. Hence it will be furnished for evaluation purpose in October Report.
- Photos pertaining to Extra cultural activities are also sent as attachment.
- Detailed Report, wherever necessary, are enclosed with the hard copies sent to Mr. Joseph sir by courier.
- Out of 12 Teachers sanctioned only 11 teachers are working. Even in the 11 teachers, 3 teachers left for various reasons and 3 new candidates have joined.. Still one vacant has to be filled in at Sankaran koil cluster. It will be accomplished in October.
- Though the monthly Report format was developed by the teachers themselves during the initial training, still they require clarity on filling certain items in the format. For example, Instead of giving the No. of students studying in their class, they give the school strength. Some of them counted the same no. of students for class room and evening class as well.
- It is felt that to bring uniformity in reporting and carrying out the activities, it is necessary to conduct 2 days orientation for further clarity and assess their experience gained as a para teacher. Since there is provision for another 5 days training to teachers, 2 days training can be planned after Deepavali which would not only be helpful to trained teachers but also to the teachers newly joined recently.
- As far as field visit is concerned, Ms. Suriya kala and Thomas visited the schools in Vilathikulam cluster and participated in conducting extra curricular activities. Dr. J. visited Sankarankoil and Triuchendur cluster.
- After observing all our discussion through emails and mobile during July & Aug'09, based on realizing the importance of coordination, a full time coordinator has been appointed exclusively for this programme by Dr. J. Needless to say that the remuneration for the coordinator will be borne by VIDIYEL as NGO contribution..
- As per final approval of revised budget, the expenses incurred for 5 days training programme held during June'09 and Cost of tool kit paid to Mr. Sudhan ie Rs. 6000 + 6000 = Rs. 12000 may kindly be released in addition to two months (.Aug & Sep)
