## ANNUAL AND EVALUATION REPORT

**LITTLE DROPS CHARITY TRUST & “KODU” SERD TRUST INTEGRATED TOGETHER TO PROVIDEN FREE COMPUTER COURSE.**

### **(A) COMPUTER**

**This project was started on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2009. We have selected a person through an interview whose name is Mr. G Krishnakumar, as computer teacher.**

**Initially we bought three computers which were sponsored by little drop charitable trust. We then started the course in a little rented house where in the room rent was provided by AIMS INDIA-Chennai.**

**The first batch, around 35 members were ready to join the course but we could accommodate only 18 members due to the lack of computers. So, we are able to complete our first batch from May 2009 to august 2009 with 18 members.**

**The same way, we could also complete the 2<sup>nd</sup> and the 3<sup>rd</sup> batch with another set of 18 members each. The 2<sup>nd</sup> batch dated from September 2009 to December 2009 and the third batch dated from January 2010 to April 2010.**

**So for a Total of 54 students we have provided the course. Mainly tribal students utilized the course and few of the non-tribal students as well.**

The evaluation is done and the report is taken from parents and the students. Nearly 34 parents and all the students were attended.

The children's told that, they got a Good Opportunity that they could gain the basic computer knowledge. Few children's praised the organization because the first time they are seeing and learning computer.

#### **(D) ACHIEVEMENTS:**

- ❖ 60% of tribal students studied in our trust and it was a great achievement
- ❖ These students was coming from long distance about 5 km
- ❖ These students was studying with great hope
- ❖ The tribal students those who haven't seen computer were given an opportunity and they came to know even to send e-mail through internet.

**(A) TAILORING**

**This Project was started on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2009. We have started the course with six machines which is donated by Little drops Charity trust. We have**

appointed Miss. C. Mini as the tailoring teacher through the interview and started classes in a rented house, located at Kolappally school main road, which is sponsored by AIMS India.

1<sup>st</sup> Batch was started from may 2009 to October 2009, with 24 woman's

2<sup>nd</sup> Batch was started from November 2009 to April 2010 with 20 women's.

The women’s who passed were given certificate in the presence of panchayat president, teachers and parents.

On 17<sup>th</sup> May 2010 Monday afternoon 1pm to 4 pm in “Koodu” trust under the leadership of Director Mr. K.J.Sunny, trustees and teachers the tailoring course women’s were evaluated according to their talent.

### (C) EVALUATION REPORT FROM WOMENS

The women’s told that little drops charity trust & “Koodu”serd trust helped us a lot. Within these six months we were able to stitch blouse, chudithar, skirt,

shirt, uniforms, etc... We have separately started a tailoring unit named as SNEHA TAILORING CENTRE and we all are benefited with that. Also Miss Dayaleni said she started tailoring at home and she is earning from it. For giving such an opportunity we are thankful to little drops trust.

### **(D) VISITING**

AIMS INDIA, Trustee & State Co-Ordinator Mr. P.V. Joseph visited our “koodu” trust for four times. He enquired about the experience of tailoring women’s and teachers and then he enquired about the teacher attendance, students attendance, bank book & exam chart paper.

AIMS INDIA, Trustee & State Co-Ordinator Mr. P.V. Joseph showed his interest in having this project in rural area visiting village leader. Through his visiting all the tailoring women’s and teachers got motivated.

### **(E) ACHIVEMENT**

- ❖ The women’s were given opportunity do earn money through this tailoring course
- ❖ The women’s trained in our tailoring centre were able to keep sneha tailoring centre and they stiched by themselves.
- ❖ Five women’s were working in tripur Banyan Company.
- ❖ By the certificate issued by our trust two women’s got tailoring machine through panchayat union.

### **(F) OUR TRUST OPINION**

- ❖ In our area there are 46732 Population. In 2011 we were able to change our tailoring centre with many more people will able to get great benefit.
- ❖ Those who are trained in this area should be given opportunity in other company.
- ❖ The backward women’s in our society shall be given tailoring machine and so it will be useful to them.
- ❖ The women’s learned in our tailoring centre should provide tailoring centre in different area.
- ❖ Tailoring course should be continued in other rural area as well. And though this many women’s will get benefit.
